Public Members Policy

1. Background

In order to recognise the contributions and interest of the public, in matters which relate to both conservation and to EALT, the Board wishes to create various categories of Supporters of the Company, or members.

2. Voting Members

The Edmonton and Area Land Trust (EALT) is an Alberta part 9 Company and a registered charity. Our shareholders in the company are our founding Members. These Members of the company are entitled to notice of member meetings and entitled to vote. They are considered Voting members. They are subscribers to the Company Memorandum and Articles in Association

3. Non-Voting Members

The categories of supporter of the company which may be held by members of the public or others may include but are not limited to:

Volunteer Member: Individuals who volunteer to assist The Edmonton and Area Land Trust in carrying out its programs and activities

Supporting Member: Any individual may become a supporting member by providing a donation of funds to the Edmonton and Area Land Trust

Honourary Member: The Board of Directors may honour outstanding conservationists by electing them to honorary memberships

Associate Member: The Board may accept as Associate members such Societies, Associations, or Groups not organized for profit as it may deem to have interest and objectives compatible and supportive of the objectives of EALT

Patron: The Board may invite an honorary member resident in Alberta to be the Patron of EALT, with no obligations to EALT, except that the Patron's name shall appear on select materials and publications
